Club Triumph 2019 Table Top Rally

- 1. Announcement:** Club Triumph will run a Table Top Rally for Novices and Newcomers to the world of Navigational Rallies, taking place throughout 2019. This is to encourage those members who are unsure of what is involved and perhaps a little timid, to have a go at one of our 12 Car Rallies.
- 2. Eligibility:** The event is open to all members of Club Triumph. Those who have previously taken part in a 12 Car Rally as an Expert will not be eligible for an award.
- 3. Event Organisers:** Nigel Abdullah, Dale Barker and Ellis Stokes.
- 4. Entries and Entry List:** Entry is free and is to be made online via the website. The entry list opens upon publication of these rules and will be available on the website.
- 5. Documentation:** All documentation can be found online, including notes that are designed to assist with the different types of navigation to be used.
- 6. Objective:** The objective of the event is to plot a specific route from the supplied route section clues, which will be in a number of differing formats. At the end of each section there will be a number of questions designed to provide evidence that you have plotted the correct route.
- 7. Equipment & Costs:** Map, romer, pencil, rubber, highlighters & a method of measuring the distance between two points such as a ruler. Some navigators use a piece of string for this. OS map used to plot the route is Landranger Map 153, Bedford and Huntingdon, dated 2014 reprinted in February 2016, with a tree lined avenue on the cover. We cannot guarantee older versions will work. We suggest www.dash4it.co.uk presently costing £6.29 including VAT & free delivery, and the romer www.harveymaps.co.uk at £1.50 including VAT but NOT postage.
- 8. Awards:** An award will be given to the overall winner.
- 9. Route:** The route will be entirely on map 153 from the Ordnance Survey Landranger series.
- 10. Control Stops:** Each section will end at a virtual Passage Control [PC], the location of which you will need to work out.
- 11. Data Protection Act:** Prospective entrants and competitors are advised that information supplied on the entry form will be held on computer and will only be used for the administration of the event. Please be aware that entrants' names and basic car details will be posted on Club Triumph's website with the results.
